NEW CLASSES for 2012

Revised classes have been introduced to the championship in 2012 as follows. Please note these when completing your registration.

1. The championship classes will be as follows

1. Experts in petrol cars 1301 - 1400cc
2. Experts in petrol cars 1001 - 1300cc
3. Experts in petrol cars up to 1000cc and diesel cars up to 2000cc
4. Semi-Experts in petrol cars 1301 - 1400cc
5. Semi-Experts in petrol cars 1001 - 1300cc
6. Semi-Experts in petrol cars up to 1000cc and diesel cars up to 2000cc
7. Novices in petrol cars up to 1400cc and diesel cars up to 2000cc

2. Expert – A driver or navigator who, at the time of registration, has finished in the top 3 of any Endurance Road Rally or at least 3 times in the top 5 of any National B road rally. Competitors who are experts in another relevant category of motor sport may also be considered experts. If you think you may fall into this category, please discuss it with the Championship co-ordinator.

3. Semi-Expert – A driver or navigator who, at the time of registration, falls outside the definition of Master or Novice

4. Novice – A driver or Navigator who, at the time of registration, has finished no more than 5 National B Road Rallies.

5. Classes in individual events may vary from event to event. Points will be allocated on the basis of championship classes and not event classes. Contenders will remain in the same experience classification for the season regardless of results after registration.
